Camping rules & regulations for Heritage Picnic area:

- Campsites are only available Friday the 9th & Saturday the 10th.
- All campers must register and pay for camping by Thursday, Sept. 1st. After September 1st, camping registration will be closed. Fees are \$30 for the weekend.
- Check in time for camping is between: 3 - 7 pm on Friday, 12-3 pm on Saturday. Check out time: By 12 noon on Sunday.
- A camping unit is defined as: (1) tent or pick up camper.
- Only one camping unit per reservation, per site, with a maximum of 7 people per camping unit.
- Fees for camping are \$30 for the weekend. Even if staying only one night, you must pay the full amount.
- There will not be designated sites for tent camping, there will be designated areas for tents on the grass. You will have to carry in your gear to an open area to set up.
- Every Camping Unit must display their camping tag on their tent or truck camper at all times. Plus have your reservation receipt on hand if asked for it. If your camping tag is not displayed on your tent, the tent will be packed up and removed.
- Pets are permitted in the campground and all areas of the State Park, please follow all rules & regulations concerning pets. Pets MUST NOT BE left unattended in a vehicle or tent at any time.
- There will be NO: water, electricity, sewage dump stations, showers, or any other amenities available to campers.
- A vault toilet and multiple Portable Latrines will be provided.
- Quiet hours will be 9 pm to 8 am.
- Generators are only allowed from 9 am to 9 pm.
- You are responsible to properly dispose of your litter into a receptacle.
- No campfires allowed, on the ground or in fire pans.
- Camping stoves and BBQs are permitted.
- Campers will only be allowed on public roadways and the Heritage Picnic area of Giant Springs State Park between sunset and sunrise. The rest of the park is closed from sunset to sunrise.
- Giant Springs State Park is not responsible for your belongings left at the site, you are responsible.
- All other Montana State Park rules still apply.
